



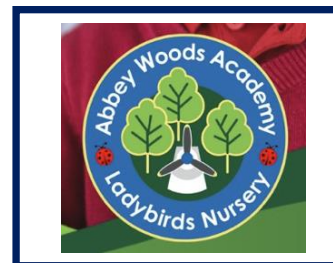
AWA NEWS
