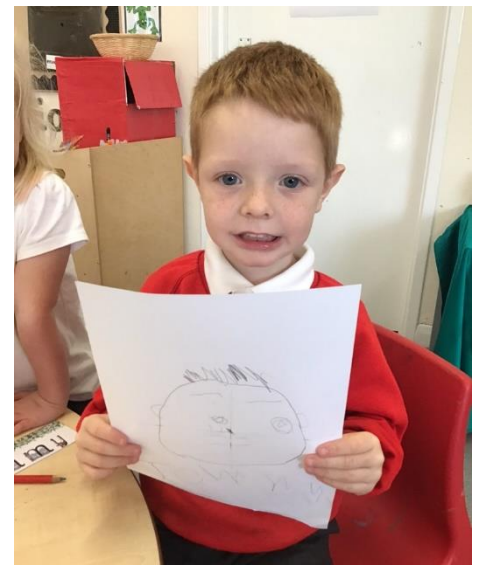

Reception

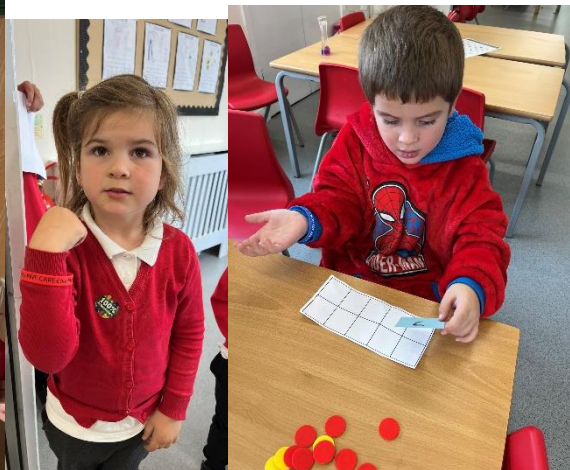
