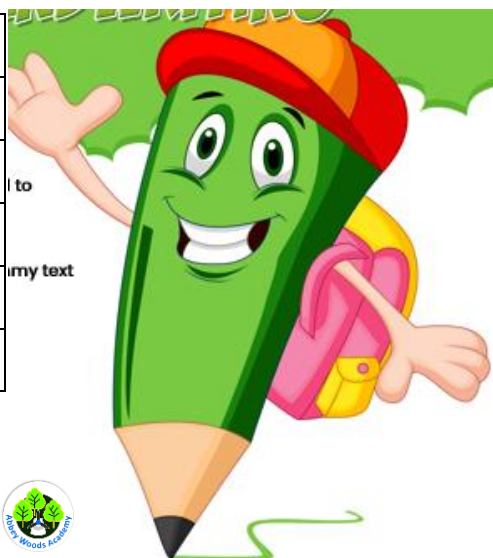
#WeCARE Celebration Assembly Awards
