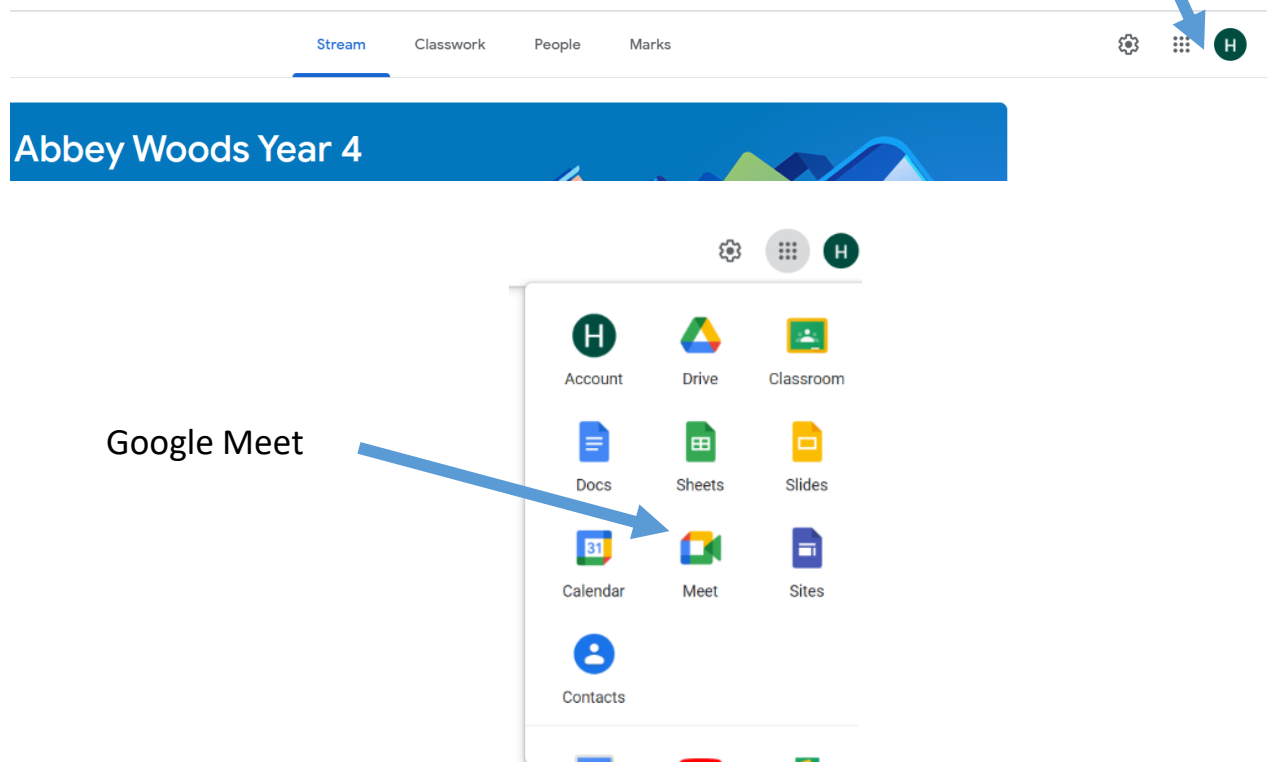


Google Meet

A Google Meet is a video meeting where children can meet with their teacher at the beginning of each day. Please note that no child can start their own meeting or join the class meeting before an adult is present.

Joining a meeting

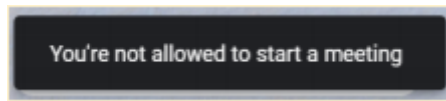
- 1) After logging into your Google Classroom, click on the waffle (9 dots in the top right hand corner) and select 'Meet'



- 2) Click on **Use a meeting code** and a box will pop up. Type in the class code given by your teacher on the stream.
