

### English

- To write a diary entry from the perspective of Kester from The Last Wild.
- To write a formal report based on different animals from The Last Wild.
- To write our own dystopian future narrative.

### Science

In Science our theme is Evolution and Inheritance.

- Recognise that living things have changed over time and that fossils provide information about living things that inhabited the Earth millions of years ago.
- Recognise that living things produce offspring of the same kind, but normally offspring vary and are not identical to their parents.
- Identify how animals and plants are adapted to suit their environment in different ways and that adaptation may lead to evolution.

### Mathematics

- Draw 2-D shapes using given dimensions and angles.
- Compare and classify geometric shapes based on their properties and sizes and find unknown angles in any triangles, quadrilaterals and regular polygons.
- Recognise angles where they meet at a point, are on a straight line, or are vertically opposite, and find missing angles.
- Illustrate and name parts of circles, including radius, diameter and circumference and know that the diameter is twice the radius.

### Art: Photography

- To use text and image together to create meaningful and powerful photo posters
- To understand abstract art through photography
- To develop a self portrait from a photograph and translate it into a drawing
- To replicate the mood and expression of a painting through photography
