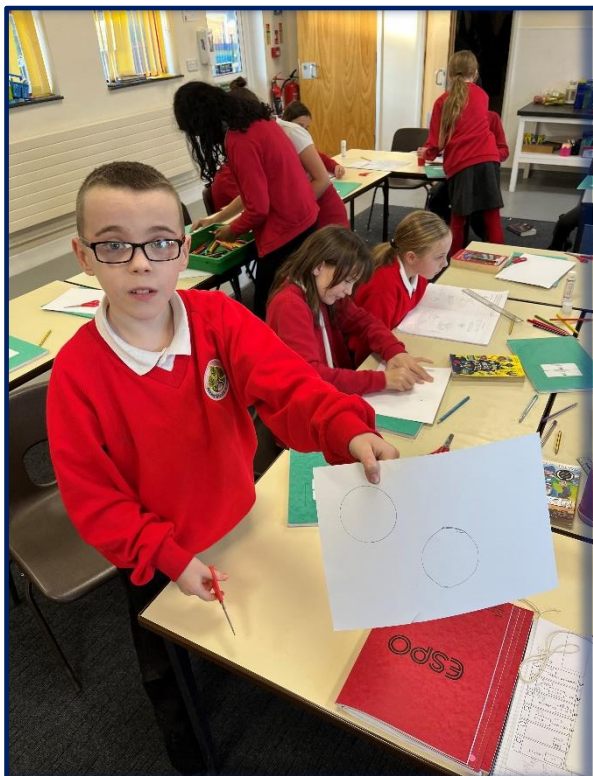


Y6 Science
