

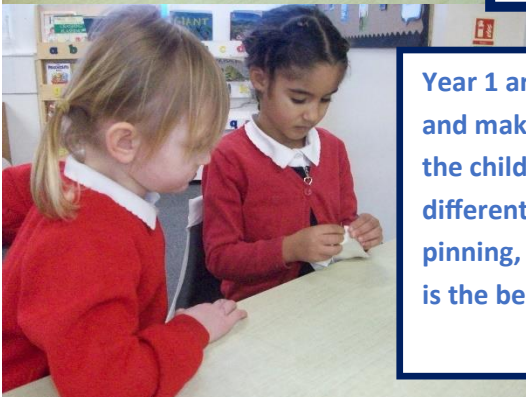


# AWA NEWS
