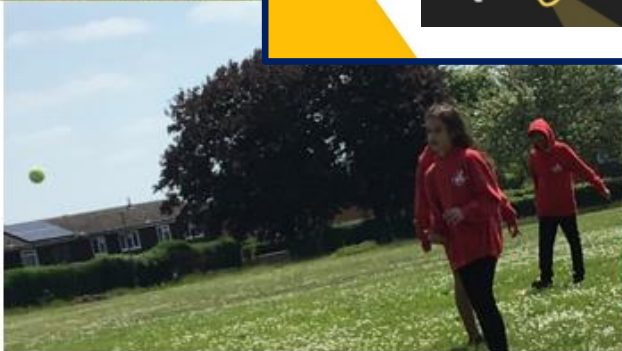
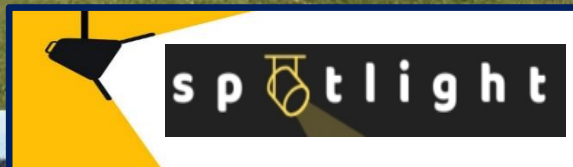
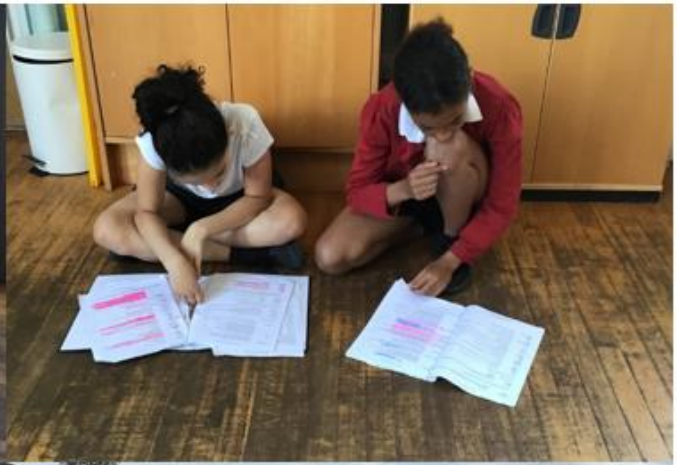




# AWA NEWS
