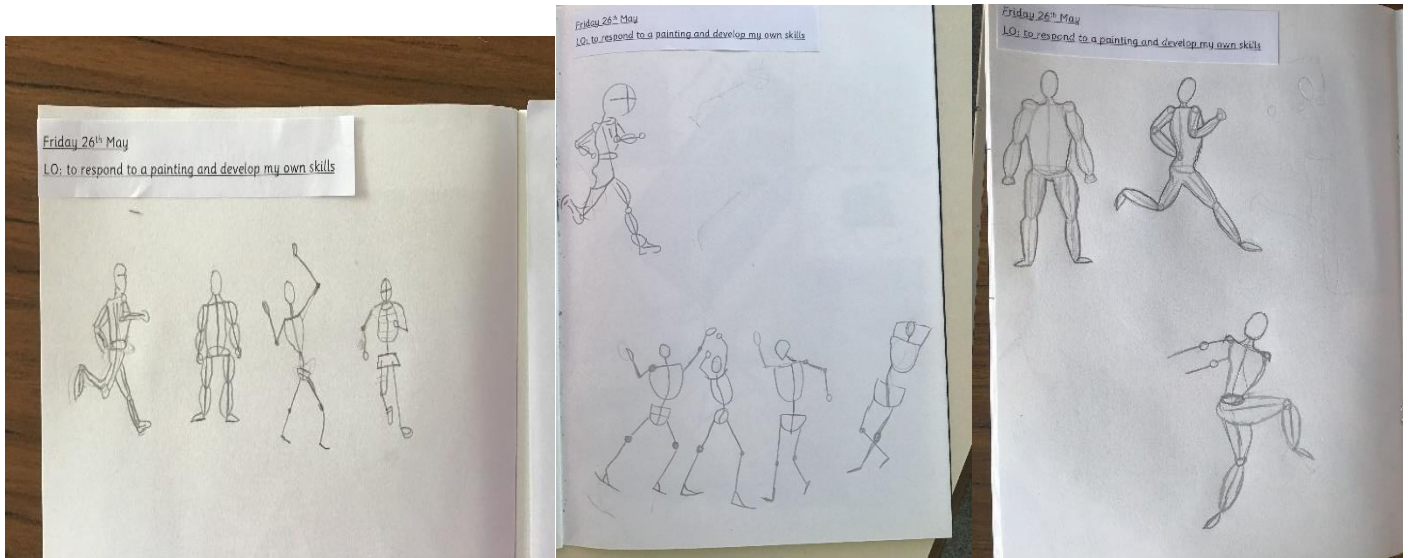
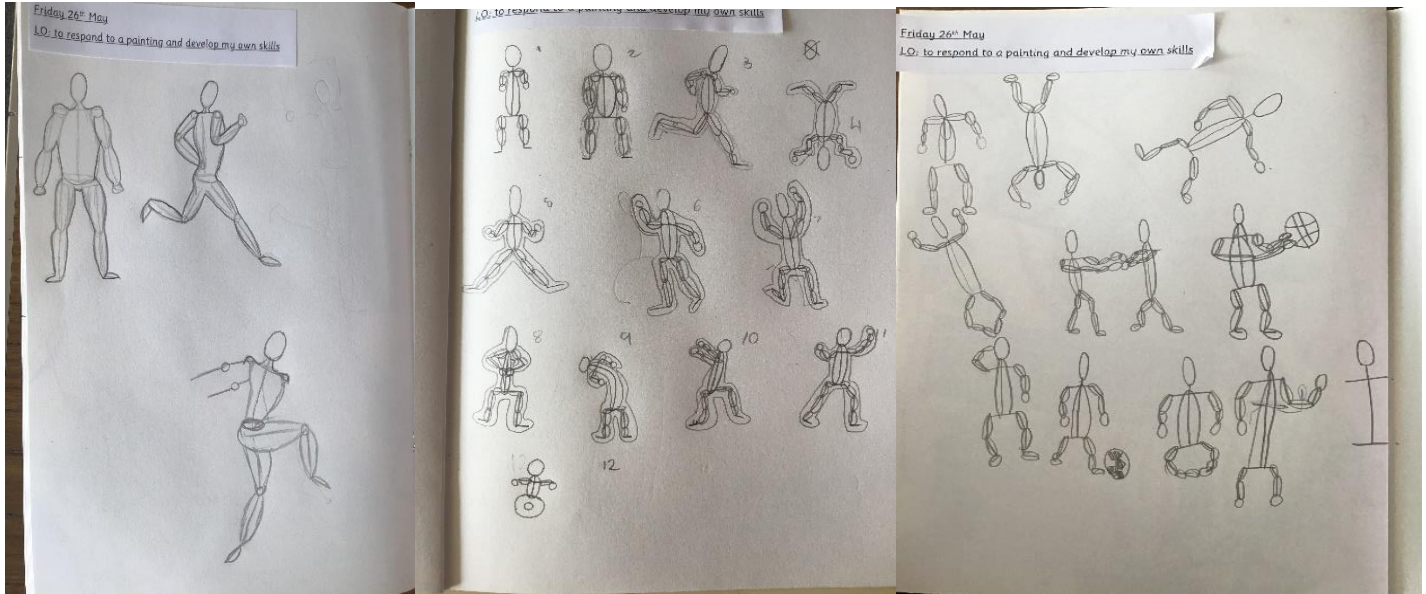




AWA NEWS
